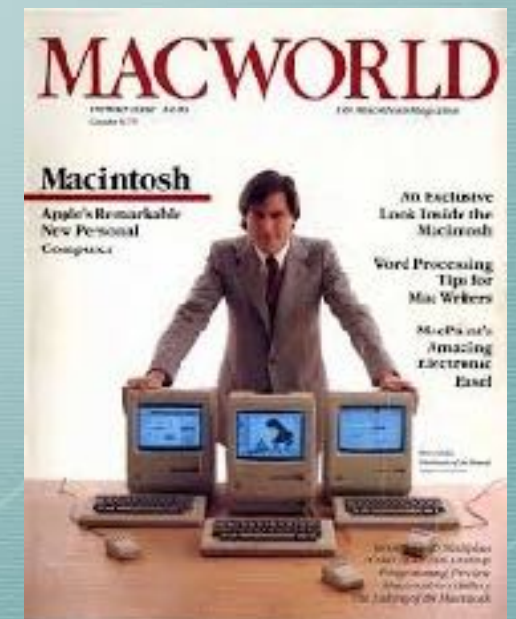

- Apple Discontinues the iPod nano and iPod shuffle



- Update to iOS 10.3.3 NOW! : Apple patches serious Wi-Fi exploit. Affected devices are the iPhone 5 and later, fourth-generation iPads and later, and the sixth-generation iPod touch
- Apple's third-quarter earnings soar on the back of booming iPad sales. \$8.7 billion profit, or \$1.67 per share, on revenue of \$45.4 billion ... BILLION!

- How to “Safely” Bulk Delete images from your iPhone

- Connect your iPhone to your Mac

- Note YOUR Mac

- Launch Image Capture app from your Mac

- Select your iPhone

- I recommend “Import All” first to your Mac

- either to Photos or just a Folder to review/edit later

- Once images saved, Select the images to Delete, then from the File Menu select Delete.

# WHAT IS APPLE KEYCHAIN?

- Apple's integrated password and sensitive data management solution
- iCloud Keychain has been available from iOS 7.0.3 and macOS 10.9
- Mac Keychain has been available since Mac OS 8.6
- Uses 2-factor authentication to access on new devices

# WHAT CAN KEYCHAIN DO

- Stores usernames, passwords, sign-on info (addresses etc) and credit cards in a secure location
- Uses iCloud to sync across all devices with Keychain turned on and connected to an iCloud account
- Repopulates stored information in websites, sign-in services and works with 3rd Party applications



# WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH KEYCHAIN?

- Recall your password and sign on information for websites automatically when you open that site
- Recall credit card information when a site asks for it
- Automatically sign in to Wi-Fi access
- Auto-login to services such as Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn
- Keep Mail, Contacts, Calendar and message accounts in sync with usernames and passwords across all devices
- Have Keychain create and manage highly secure passwords for you





# WHAT IS THE ADVANTAGE OF KEYCHAIN

- Integrated tightly into the Apple ecosystem
- Makes it easier to manage all your different passwords and access information in a secure manner
- Synchronise information across all your devices



# DANGERS OF KEYCHAIN

- All your eggs in one basket - if something goes wrong you lose all your info (can use another device to access if the problem is local)
- Should have an alternate password manager for safety
- Known issue and solution...
